

## DRAFT AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 28, FOOD REGULATIONS 1985

To include the definitions of ceramic cooking ware and maximum permitted proportion of lead and cadmium under Regulation 28, Food Regulations 1985: Ceramic Ware as follows:

- **New Subregulation 28 (2):**

**(h) "cooking ware" means any ceramic ware which intended to be heated by conventional thermal methods or microwaves.**

- **Amendment of Thirteenth Schedule: Maximum Permitted Proportion of Lead and Cadmium Release**

Type of ceramic ware	$n^a$	Maximum permitted proportion criterion	Unit of measure	Lead	Cadmium
Cooking ware	4	all specimens $\leq$ maximum permitted proportion	mg/l	0.5	0.05

<sup>a</sup>  $n$  is the number of specimens in the sample under test which are identical in size, shape, colour and decoration.
