- 6. **Description of content:** The measure represents a temporary restriction on import of live poultry and hatching eggs, poultry meat and all kinds of poultry products, not heat treated (at least 70 °C), feed and feed additives for poultry (except feed additives of chemical and microbiological synthesis), used equipment for keeping, slaughter and butchering of birds, down and feather from Canada (Oxford county, Ontario) to the territory of the Russian Federation due to an outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza.
- 7. Objective and rationale: [X] food safety, [X] animal health, [] plant protection, [X] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [] protect territory from other damage from pests.
- 8. Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: This letter introduces a temporary restriction on imports from Oxford county, Ontario (Canada) of the products mentioned in point 3, due to the outbreak of highly pathogenic avian influenza.
