

DRAFT AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR FERTILIZERS

The definition of the Official Specifications will be amended by the provision of the Article 3(1) of the Fertilizer Regulation Act.

Amendment of the Official Specifications for the following ordinary fertilizer
“Mixed Sludge Compound Fertilizers” with three-year-term validity of registration
