Summary of the revised Part B of the "Quarantine Requirements for the Importation of Plants or Plant Products":

- (1) India is added as an infested area of *Frankliniella occidentalis* based on relevant scientific evidence. The host plants (entire or any part of living plants, [excluding seeds and underground portion]) of *Frankliniella occidentalis* from India shall be accompanied by phytosanitary certificates, stating that the plants have been inspected and found free from *Frankliniella occidentalis* or stating that the plants or plant parts have undergone an appropriate quarantine treatment prior to shipment.
- (2) Two insects, *Aonidiella orientalis* and *Coccidohystrix insolita* were added to the regulated pest list, and the scientific names of 1 fungus, *Verticillium dahliae*, and 1 nematode, *Hoplolaimus* spp., were corrected.
