#### Supplementary Provisions

(Effective Date)

Article 1 This Cabinet Office Ordinance comes into effect as of the date of promulgation.

(Transitional Measures)

Article 2 With regard to the display (limited to the display set forth in the provisions pertaining to this revision) of Processed Food manufactured or processed for the period from the day when this Ordinance comes into effect to March 31, 2022 (excluding Processed Food for Business Use), and raw materials and Processed Food both for Business Use sold by the said date, notwithstanding Chapter 2 and Chapter 3 of the Food Labeling Standards after the revision by this Ordinance and Article 4 of its Supplementary Provisions, the provisions then in force may remain applicable.

Article 3 With regard to the display of Processed Food in the manufacturing process in a manufacturing or processing site at the time this Ordinance comes into effect, notwithstanding the preceding Article, the provisions then in force may remain applicable.
