Addendum

The following communication, dated 5 December 2003, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Canada.

Regulations Amending the Food and Drug Regulations (1315 - Fosetyl-aluminum)

This regulatory amendment will establish a maximum residue limit (MRL) for residues of fosetyl-aluminum resulting from this use in bok choy cabbage and Chinese broccoli, in order to permit the sale of food containing these residues.

After the review of all available data, the Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has determined that an MRL for fosetyl-aluminum of 60 ppm in bok choy cabbage and Chinese broccoli would not pose an unacceptable health risk to the public.
