AGREEMENT REACHED BY A MEMBER WITH ANOTHER COUNTRY OR COUNTRIES ON ISSUES RELATED TO TECHNICAL REGULATIONS, STANDARDS OR CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT PROCEDURES

Notification

Under Article 10.7 of the Agreement "Whenever a Member has reached an agreement with any other country or countries on issues related to technical regulations, standards or conformity assessment procedures which may have a significant effect on trade, at least one Member party to the agreement shall notify other Members through the Secretariat of the products to be covered by the agreement and include a brief description of the agreement." The following notification under Article 10.7 has been received.

1.	Member notifying: <u>UKRAINE</u>
2.	Title of the bilateral or plurilateral Agreement: Memorandum of Understanding in the area of standardization and metrology between the State Committee of Ukraine for Technical Regulation and Consumer Policy and the Libyan National Center for Standardization and Metrology (LNCSM).
3.	Parties to the Agreement: Libya, Ukraine
4.	Date of entry into force of Agreement: 4 November 2008
5.	Products covered (HS or CCCN where applicable, otherwise national tariff heading): Groups of goods are not specified, the Framework Agreement.
6.	Subject matter covered by the Agreement (technical regulations, standards or conformity assessment procedures): Standards.

7. Description of measures of Agreement: The agreement provides development of cooperation in the following areas:

- Harmonization of national standards with international and european ones, particularly in the areas of industry that concern the common interests;
- Development and improvement of national systems of standardization in accordance with international practices;
- Exchange of publications and information in the area of standardization;
- Invite experts to seminars and conferences on standardization;
- Information on training programs and practical training courses;
- Cooperation within the framework of participation in international organizations for standardization.
