6.	Description of content: This document provides advance notice of a proposal to amend the customs regulations to prescribe specific rules regarding the country of origin marking of watches to ensure that the marking is conspicuous and legible.
7.	Objective and rationale: The purpose of this proposal is to assist in determining whether a rulemaking is needed to ensure a uniform standard for the conspicuous and legible country of origin marking for watches, and if needed, the contents of that rulemaking.
