6.	Description of content: This proposed rule would revise the United States standards for grades of table grapes (European or Vinifera type). The proposal would lower the present minimum bunch size as well as provide a separate tolerance for off-size bunches for the U.S. No. 1 institutional grade only. It would also include a technical update which would correct the variety name "Superior Seedless" to "Sugraone".
7.	Objective and rationale: To improve quality. This standard is referenced in the regulations under the Agricultural Marketing Agreement of 1937.
