COMMUNICATION FROM CHILE

Addendum

The following communication, received on 16 November 2022, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Chile.

1. The Agriculture and Livestock Service of Chile (SAG) hereby advises that:

On 24 October 2022, SAG repealed the provisions set out in point 6 of document [G/SPS/GEN/1770](#) of 2 April 2020, which established facilities for the submission of original phytosanitary certificates in order to export to Chile, in response to the disruption caused by the COVID-19 virus.

2. The above-mentioned decision has been made due to the return to normality seen worldwide and the fact that airlines and courier services are operating without any issues.

3. This information was shared with IPPC contact points on 25 October 2022.

4. Lastly, Chile states that this communication is being made for the purposes of transparency, without prejudice to the country's rights and obligations under the SPS Agreement.
