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## INTRODUCTION

1. The Doha Ministerial Declaration, adopted on 14 November 2001, confirms that technical cooperation and capacity-building are core elements of the development dimension of the multilateral trading system. Ministers established an extensive mandate and undertook a firm set of commitments on technical cooperation and capacity building to enable beneficiary countries implement WTO rules and obligations, prepare them for effective participation in the work of the WTO, including for future negotiations and an extensive Work Programme, as well as to enable them to draw on the benefits of the open, rules-based multilateral trading system.

2. This Coordinated WTO Secretariat Annual Technical Assistance Plan for 2002 is work in progress. Effective implementation of the Plan began on 1 January 2002. However, the Plan will be in dynamic evolution, and will be subject to regular reviews. Members are yet to fully absorb the realities of what is specifically needed for the implementation of the Doha Development agenda. This plan is one of 6 levels of action that the WTO will pursue in the implementation of the technical cooperation and capacity building objectives in 2002, including those objectives that are mandated by the Doha Ministerial Declaration. **The six levels of action, which will be pursued interdependently are:**

- (i) **effective coordinated delivery of technical assistance with well-defined inter-agency groups/multilateral agencies, focused on issues.** This level will focus on all areas, including on the Singapore Issues, and areas where synergies would be required with other multilateral institutions. The Doha Ministerial Declaration establishes an unprecedented agenda and set of commitments on technical cooperation and capacity building. The WTO, on its own, cannot implement all the commitments. It is indispensable that strategic partnerships are established with other agencies with related competencies. These partnerships require careful negotiation and coordination. Discussions have begun in this regard, and are well advanced in several areas such as Investment, Competition, Trade Facilitation, the Integrated Framework, Standards, etc. The membership will be informed on these partnerships as they are firmly established, and as they evolve. This issue-focused partnerships will be the Integrated Framework (IF) writ small;
- (ii) **the Integrated Framework for Trade-Related Technical Assistance to the Least-Developed Countries.** This is an area where a strategic inter-agency partnership, with representatives of bilateral donors and LDCs' beneficiaries, has already been established. Action at this level will be based on the re-vamped Integrated Framework as a mechanism for *mainstreaming* trade priority areas of action into the development plans and strategies for poverty reduction of the LDCs, and also a mechanism for actual delivery. LDCs remain the priority category for the delivery of WTO Trade-Related Technical Assistance. The Integrated Framework Heads of Agency met on 26 February 2002, and issued a Communiqué that further strengthened the Integrated Framework;<sup>1</sup>
- (iii) **Creation and management of a WTO Trade-Related Technical Assistance Database.** This database is necessary for improved coherence and coordinated delivery of technical assistance by providers (agencies and countries). The database will minimise the distortions that often arise in the area of technical cooperation, transparently show activities that are being delivered and, hopefully, eliminate duplication and other inefficiencies. The

creation and management of this database is a cooperative exercise amongst agency and country providers of technical assistance. Information will be made available to Members on the functioning of the database;

- (iv) **Effective coordinated delivery of technical assistance by the WTO and bilateral donors in the Development Assistance Committee of the OECD.** The bilateral donors, within the framework of the Development Assistance Committee of the OECD, providers of the greater quantum of technical assistance, including at country level. Agencies of the Integrated Framework held a first-ever meeting with bilateral donors in the DAC/OECD, 17-18 January 2002, to better coordinate trade-related technical assistance delivery not only in favour of the LDCs, but also in implementation of the Doha mandates on technical cooperation and capacity building<sup>2</sup>. This meeting of agencies and donors will re-convene in December 2002 to evaluate progress made in the delivery of trade-related technical assistance in the implementation of the Doha mandates on technical cooperation and capacity building;
- (v) **Strategic partnerships with Regional Banks, Institutions and Commissions. Regional pillars are a requirement for the effective implementation of the mandates<sup>3</sup>.** The Secretariat is in the process of negotiating and concluding Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) with regional development banks, with resources that could be set aside for technical assistance, concessional and non-concessional lending for trade-related projects, and trade financing. Several of the regional banks already contacted are willing to enter into joint delivery of training for trade officials with the WTO, and to cooperate in the areas of *mainstreaming* trade into national economic development plans and strategies for poverty reduction. One important objective in the arrangements with regional banks will be to pursue regional joint meetings of trade and finance ministers in order to support the process of better integrating trade priority areas of action into overall economic policies and poverty reduction strategies. Seminars will also be jointly conducted together with these regional banks, institutions and regional commissions. Regular information and updates will be provided to the Committee on Trade and Development; and,
- (vi) **Finally, the annual Secretariat-wide Technical Cooperation Plan, to be delivered mainly by the WTO Secretariat** (and to an extent in coordination with multilateral agencies with related competence, as indicated in the appropriate columns). This Plan is the first in the series of annual plans. In the implementation of this Plan, the Committee on Trade and Development (COMTD) will be more effectively used for reporting on activities, updates, and evaluations.

3. This document focuses on the WTO Secretariat-wide Annual TA Plan, as in paragraph 2(vi) above. Pursuant to the Doha Ministerial Declaration, previous decisions by Members, and Secretariat practice, activities in this Annual Technical Assistance Plan are based on inputs from five sources namely:

- (i) the mandates on technical cooperation and capacity building in the Doha Ministerial Declaration as contained in paragraphs 16, 21, 24, 26, 27, 33, 38-40, 42 and 43;
- (ii) the New Strategy for WTO Technical Cooperation for Capacity-building, Growth and Integration, endorsed by Ministers in paragraph 38 of the Doha Declaration;
- (iii) the dynamic and on-going demands received from the membership and countries in accession to the WTO Secretariat (operational divisions and the Technical Cooperation Division). Inputs into the Plan from this source takes account of the fact that WTO TA remains demand driven;
- (iv) the stand-alone decisions on technical cooperation taken by Members such as in paragraph 14 of the Negotiating Guidelines for the Services Negotiations, the decision on technical assistance by the Customs Valuation Committee, and others; and
- (v) coordinated inputs (not simply a compilation) from Operational Divisions and the TCD, emerging from meetings of the Technical Assistance Management Committee (TAMC), based on Divisional conceptions of optimal delivery of TA within their substantive jurisdictions.

4. Having regard to the five sources of inputs to this Plan (as stated in the foregoing paragraph ), each activity in this 2002 Plan has been explicitly linked to the specific mandates contained in 11 operative paragraphs in the Declaration, indicated in the table below:

5. In practice, this means that in the implementation of the proposed activities, the Secretariat shall work towards a clear understanding on how they relate to, and reflect the pertinent commitments on technical cooperation (TC) and capacity building (CB) in the Doha Ministerial Declaration. It should also be understood that the activities as set out in this document are designed to focus and deepen the relevant technical assistance commitments of the Doha Ministerial Declaration. The implementation of these activities will focus on addressing the commitments of the Declaration and activities supportive of those commitments.

6. In light of the above, this Secretariat's Annual Plan for 2002 is divided into sections. Activities that cover more than one subject-matter have been inscribed in the section that is considered more relevant. The following sections are used:

7. To conclude this introduction, six additional points require underscore. **First**, this plan has been subjected to the fullest possible internal coordination by the Technical Assistance Management Committee in light of information available to it in the immediate post-Doha period. This Plan has also been revised in extensive consultations with Members. It is understood that it cannot be considered as exhaustive because many Members (in particular, developing and least-developed countries) still require deeper assessment of the technical cooperation implications in support of their policy objectives and actions. As a result, strictness in the execution of this plan needs to be combined with flexibility in implementation. There will be, however, limits to interpretations of flexibility. For instance, the Plan is being implemented on the understanding that *ad hoc* requests<sup>4</sup> shall be limited to the barest minimum. *Ad hoc* requests had a destabilizing effect on the former 3-year plans. These requests did impact negatively on the ability of the Secretariat to focus and deliver on the planned activities. Furthermore, because the number of planned activities in 2002 exceeds the levels for previous years, the Secretariat shall attach priority to planned activities, and will seek the understanding of Members in ensuring adherence to this Annual Plan. *Ad hoc* requests and activities that arise or are requested by Members will be considered for the 2003 Plan, except in the most exceptional of circumstances.

8. **Second**, this Plan needs to be read in conjunction with a number of other technical assistance activities that are being carried out beyond the Doha Development Agenda. This is the case, *inter alia*, of the planned activities of the WTO Training Institute, which are presented to the Committee on Trade and Development in document WT/COMTD/W/89/Rev.1. Members will recall that as a result of the adoption of the WTO Budget for 2002, Members have now doubled the capacity of the WTO Training Institute to deliver on the regular trade policy courses in English, French and Spanish. Moreover, Members need to bear in mind other technical assistance activities, which are provided here in Geneva and elsewhere, but which are not subject to any WTO financing. Lastly, the Plan does not include the on-going technical assistance provided by the Secretariat to WTO Members individually at Headquarters.

9. **Third**, this WTO Annual TA Plan for 2002 is not stand-alone. It contains those activities that the WTO Secretariat can deliver within its competence, resources, and more importantly what is possible within a 12-month calendar period. However, as stated in paragraph 2, this Plan is one out of six levels of action by the WTO in responding to the technical cooperation and capacity-building mandates established by Ministers in the Doha Ministerial Declaration. It bears repeating as in paragraph 2 that the other levels are coordinated action and delivery in carefully defined areas with the bilateral donors within the DAC/OECD, relevant multilateral agencies, and on-going work in the re-vamped Integrated Framework for Trade-Related Technical Assistance to the Least-Developed Countries (IF). In the course of implementing this Plan, addenda will be issued to this document to draw to the attention of Members the factual evolution on the other levels of action as in paragraphs 2(ii) to (iv).

10. **Fourth**, the organisational changes in the WTO Secretariat by the Director General comprise the merge of the Development Division and the Economic Research and Analysis Division into the new Development and Economic Research Division. A principal rationale for this change was to adjust the Secretariat to address the development and technical cooperation and capacity-building (TCCB) mandates through, *inter alia*, research studies to provide factual analytical information for the use of developing countries in the negotiations. This economic and research basis will be an important component of the WTO Secretariat's activities on TCCB.

11. **Fifth**, the activities of this Plan will be subject to scrupulous evaluation and auditing to ensure high quality delivery and to monitor the use of technical assistance and its impact in recipient

countries. The evaluation and audit functions will be carried out by the Technical Cooperation Audit, which was separated from the Technical Cooperation Division in the 2001 reorganization of WTO technical cooperation by Senior Management.

12. **Finally**, it is essential that the technical assistance received by beneficiary countries is cumulative, contributing to the institutional capacity of beneficiary countries to participate in the multilateral trading system, implement their obligations, exercise their rights, and meaningfully draw on the benefits of the open rules-based trading system. To this end, it is necessary that the Secretariat and the Members work together to be sure that technical assistance is delivered within the coherent policy framework of national economic development plans and/or the World Bank/IMF Poverty Reduction Strategy Papers. This is one of the core elements of WTO technical assistance identified in the New Strategy for Technical Assistance (paragraph 8 of the New Strategy).<sup>5</sup> In the absence of this approach, experience has shown that, in most instances, technical assistance received non-cumulatively by beneficiary countries leads to an annual repetition of the same requests.

## ANNEX I

### Doha Development Agenda Short Trade Policy Courses

This Advanced Training Programme for Government Officials is designed to train trade negotiators of WTO Members and Observers from developing countries and economies in transition more systematically on the issues central to the Doha Development Agenda. The main purpose of this programme is to strengthen these countries' effective participation in the Doha negotiations and work programme through policy analysis, a deeper understanding of the issues involved and the range of options available.

The programme will draw on the collaboration and participation of academic centers of excellence, research institutions and policy-oriented think tanks in five regions: Africa, Asia and the Pacific, Arab and Middle East, Central and Eastern Europe and Central Asia, and Latin America and the Caribbean. It will be based on the experiences obtained through the WTO Secretariat's participation, during the past five years, in the WTO/Organization of American States/Georgetown University Advanced Training Course on Multilateral and Regional Issues of the Trade Agenda of the Americas, as well as in the regular activities of the Joint Vienna Institute (JVI). The objective of these Institute-based Short Trade Policy Courses in support of the DDA will also be reflected in the regular and Short Trade Policy Courses of the WTO Training Institute.

#### Objectives

- To strengthen the participation of government officials in the negotiations related to the Doha Development Agenda;
- To increase their understanding of negotiating issues and to analyze the various negotiating proposals and options.

#### Activities

- One Advanced Training Course per year in each of the following regions: Africa, Asia and the Pacific, Arab and Middle East, Central and Eastern Europe and Central Asia, and Latin America and the Caribbean.<sup>10</sup>

#### Duration

- From 2002 to 2004, i.e. the agreed time period for the Doha negotiations.

#### Participation

- 25-30 Government officials per region with responsibility in the areas included for negotiation in the Doha Development Agenda;
- To ensure transparency in the process, any qualified government official may apply with the support from their government;
- Selection of participants to be carried out by the WTO Secretariat in coordination with partner agencies/institutions, with a view to:

- obtaining a wide spectrum of representative responsibility;
- including officials with direct responsibility for the design and implementation of policy on the issues at hand;
- promoting networking and interface among participants, both from different countries, but also from different ministries and sectors within countries;
- ensuring participation of private sector representatives of organizations directly involved in advising the government on negotiating positions.

#### **Format and Programme**

- The WTO will join an academic institution to organize a two-week intensive Advanced Training Courses on an annual basis in each of the regions;
- Courses to be held, preferably, in the premises of academic institutions;
- Programmes to include the examination of negotiating issues under the Doha Development Agenda, from the multilateral and the regional perspectives. Inclusion of trade negotiations simulations and dispute settlement simulations;
- Lecturers and trainers to be drawn from WTO staff, academic institutions, government officials (as resource persons) and trade consultants.

#### **Immediate Action**

- It is envisaged to seek, within the next few months, possible co-sponsors in the other regions, such as the Joint Vienna Institute (JVI), the Islamic Development Bank, ESCAP Secretariat, the Asian Development Bank Institute, the ASEAN Secretariat and the New Partnership for Africa's Development (NEPAD), the Economic Commission for Africa (ECA), and to identify the academic institutions that could join in this effort;
- The programme for Latin American and Caribbean countries in collaboration with Georgetown University, Washington, and the Organization of American States (OAS) will be continued;
- In Asia, discussions will be pursued with the Indian Institute of Foreign Trade, and the Institute for Cooperation in International Economic Relations.

### ANNEX III

#### Video-Conferencing

1. Video-conferencing is an important tool for technical cooperation. Lecturing, question and answer (Q&A) sessions as well as technical missions can be effectively delivered, at a minimal cost and with considerable multiplier effect. Video-conferencing is used on a regular basis during Short Trade Policy Courses as well as in some technical missions. Video-conferencing also plays an important role in the delivery of TA whenever the Secretariat staff is not in a position to travel to a country due to conflicting schedules, security considerations or other reasons. Both participants and WTO staff have found that video-conferencing is an effective means of communication since it maintains dynamic face-to-face contact. However, it needs to be borne in mind that it is not a perfect substitute for delivery *in situ* and that beneficiary countries often demand physical presence in TA delivery, and express a preference for physical presence in the delivery of TA when faced with the choice of either a video-conference or physical presence for TA delivery.
2. The Secretariat owns a video-conferencing system that with a global reach to other video-conferencing equipment that recognizes the ITU standard H.320. The system uses ISDN telephone lines and the video quality is near-television quality at the high end. Two types of video-conferencing can be organized: point-to-point connections and multi-point links.
3. The present WTO video-conferencing equipment is used, in addition to technical cooperation activities, for several other purposes such as participation in conferences, dispute settlement panels, interview of candidates, coordination meetings, etc. In the case of lectures, for instance, presentations can easily and effectively be adapted to a video-conference format while accommodating visual tools such as power-point presentations, overhead transparencies, charts, photographs and video sequences.
4. The expected increase in size of TA activities due to the Doha Ministerial mandates, and the fact that in some instances conflicting schedules have already occurred in the past, the Secretariat plans to acquire an additional video-conferencing equipment to be used on a priority basis for the delivery of technical assistance.
