

**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES – MEASURES CONCERNING  
MEAT AND MEAT PRODUCTS (HORMONES)**

Request by the European Communities for Arbitration  
under Article 22.6 of the DSU

The following communication, dated 2 June 1999, from the Permanent Delegation of the European Commission to the Chairman of the Dispute Settlement Body, is circulated pursuant to Article 22.6 of the DSU.

My authorities have requested me to inform you that, pursuant to Article 22.6 of the DSU, the European Communities object to the level of suspension proposed by Canada in document WT/DS48/17. The European Communities believe that the figure of Canadian \$75 million of annual trade proposed by Canada is far higher than the actual level of nullification or impairment of benefits suffered by this Member because of the measures on meat and meat products maintained by the European Communities. The European Communities, therefore, request that this matter be referred to arbitration.

The European Communities also ask the arbitrators to request Canada to submit a list with proposed suspension of concessions equivalent to the level of nullification or impairment once this has been determined by the arbitrators in accordance with Article 22.7 of the DSU in conjunction with Article 22.4 of the DSU.
