



NOTE TO DELEGATIONS

HEALTH INFORMATION FOR DELEGATES ATTENDING THE ELEVENTH MINISTERIAL CONFERENCE (MC11)

Please find below a communication from the Argentine Task Force for the Eleventh Ministerial Conference.

1 HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING THE COUNTRY

1.1. According to information provided by the Directorates for Vaccine-Preventable Disease Control and Border Health Control of the Republic of Argentina, there are no mandatory health requirements for entering Argentina.

1.2. It is, however, recommended that members of delegations attending the Eleventh Ministerial Conference are up to date with their vaccinations, particularly for measles.

1.3. In light of the annual reports received by PAHO and the WHO, any delegation members travelling to the provinces of Misiones and Corrientes are advised to ensure they are vaccinated against yellow fever.

2 EMERGENCY AND MEDICAL SERVICES DURING THE CONFERENCE

2.1. A comprehensive medical emergency service will be available at all MC11 Conference venues (Buenos Aires Convention Centre, Hilton Hotel, CCK Cultural Centre and Teatro Colón).

2.2. This service will include the presence of fully equipped, highly specialized mobile intensive care units at each venue where meetings and events are taking place. The number of units on-site will depend on how many delegates are in attendance. Medical professionals and drivers will be present at all times, and have the necessary logistical support.

2.3. In addition, each of the above-mentioned Conference venues, including the Teatro Colón, will have a medical room staffed by medical professionals, and ambulances on standby.
