

NOTIFICATION OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS  
UNDER ARTICLE 18.5 OF THE AGREEMENT

Supplement

The Committee decided in its special meeting of 21 February 1995 that all Members which have available legislation and/or regulations regarding anti-dumping duty investigations or reviews covered by the Agreement shall notify the full and integrated text of the relevant legislation and/or regulations to the Committee by **15 March 1995**. If such legislation and/or regulations do not exist or are not yet available, the Member will inform the Committee of this fact, and will explain the reasons therefore. As further agreed by the Committee, these notifications will be treated as unrestricted documents.

The Committee also adopted the following decision regarding Observer governments:

An Observer government shall provide the Committee with any information the Observer government considers relevant to matters within the purview of the Agreement, including the text of its laws and regulations regarding anti-dumping duties, and information regarding any anti-dumping measures taken by the Observer government. At the request of any Party or the Observer government itself, any matter contained in such information could be brought to the attention of the Committee after governments have been allowed sufficient time to examine the information.

Laws and regulations submitted by Observer governments in response to this invitation will be circulated as addenda to G/ADP/N/1.
