## Corrigendum

Please note that the first sentence of the chapeau on page 1 should read as follows:

"The Committee on Import Licensing held its twentieth meeting on 30 September 2004."

Please replace paragraphs 1.9 and 6.3 with the following:

- "1.9 The <u>Chairperson</u> stated that since the last meeting questions from delegations on notifications of licensing systems had been circulated in the G/LIC/Q/- series. Although the Secretariat had sent reminders, only six delegations had provided replies to questions in writing. The replies were from Argentina (G/LIC/Q/ARG/2), India (G/LIC/Q/IND/9), Brazil (G/LIC/Q/BRA/2), China (G/LIC/Q/CHN/10), Indonesia (G/LIC/Q/IDN/5) and Jamaica (G/LIC/Q/JAM/2) to the US; and from Indonesia (G/LIC/Q/IDN/6 & Add.1) to Australia. The US had submitted questions in writing to Argentina in G/LIC/Q/ARG/1, India in G/LIC/Q/IND/8 and Jamaica in G/LIC/Q/JAM/1. Replies from Jamaica, in G/LIC/Q/JAM/2, were received too late and would be considered at the next meeting."
- "6.3 The delegate of the <u>EC</u> stated that the TRQ's administration for pig meat was an issue which had been raised by the US delegation partially at the Committee on Agriculture on 23 September 2004 (G/AG/R/40, page 3). At this meeting of the Committee on Agriculture the EC has replied that date of reference for the last licensing notification was 1 July 2003 and regulation 1458/2003 was published only in August 2003. It could therefore not have been included in the licensing notification. The EC also indicated that there was nothing new in this system, which dated back to 1995. The full text of the predecessor of regulation 1458/2003, regulation 1486/1995, was included in notification G/AG/N/EEC/1/Add.2, G/AG/N/EEC/3/Add.1, G/AG/N/EEC/14/Add.1, G/AG/N/EEC/15/Add.1 of 14 June 2001 (pages 86-90 of the printed document). She would respond to the questions concerning enriched uranium at the next meeting."
