

AGREEMENT ON IMPORT LICENSING PROCEDURES

Notification under Articles 1.4(a) and 8.2(b)

CAMEROON

The following communication, dated 13 July 2001, has been received from the Ministry of Trade and Industrial Development of the Republic of Cameroon.

Pursuant to Articles 1.4(a) and 8.2(b) of the Agreement on Import Licensing Procedures, the Government of Cameroon notifies the Committee on Import Licensing that it has available the publications which contain rules and information relevant to the Agreement. The Government of Cameroon submits herewith copies of these documents.¹ They are:

- Decree No. 88/1285 of 23 September 1988 implementing Law No. 88/007 of 15 July 1988 establishing an import control and inspection duty in Cameroon;
