

AGREEMENT ON IMPORT LICENSING PROCEDURES

Notification under Article 5

INDONESIA

The following communication, dated 28 April 2009, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Indonesia.

Pursuant to Article 5.2 of Agreement on Import Licensing Procedures regarding institution of import licensing procedures, the Government of Indonesia is notifying¹ to the Committee on Import Licensing Procedures, relating to:

1. Regulation of the Minister of Trade No. 08/M-DAG/Per/2/2009 dated 18 February 2009 on Provisions on the Import of Iron or Steel, and
 2. Regulation of Minister of Trade No. 56/M-DAG/PER/12/2008 dated 24 December 2008 on Provision of the Import of Certain Products.

1. Regulation of the Minister of Trade No. 08/M-DAG/Per/2/2009 dated 18 February 2009 on Provisions on the Import of Iron or Steel

- (a) List of products subject to licensing procedures:

Iron or steel, HS No. 7208, 7209, 7210, 7211, 7213, 7214, 7215, 7216, 7217, 7219, 7229, 7301, 7304, 7305, 7306, 7307, 7308, 7311, 7312, 7314, 7317, 7318, and 7321.

- (f) In the case of automatic import licensing procedures, their administrative purpose:

In order to secure recognition as IP of Iron or Steel or stipulation of IT of Iron or Steel, every company shall submit application to the Director General by enclosing the following documents:

- a. Importer Identity Number (API):
 1. Producer Importer Identity Number/ Limited Importer Identity Number (API-P/API-T) in the case of the company being IP of Iron or Steel; or
 2. General Importer Identity Number (API-U) in the case of the company being IT or Iron or Steel;
- b. Corporate Registry Number (TDP);
- c. Taxpayer Code Number (NPWP);
- d. Customs Identity Number (NIK);
- e. Import plan for one year, covering quantity, kinds of goods, tariff heading/ HS 10 (ten) digits and destination port;
- f. Technical consideration from the Director General of Metal, Machine, Textile and Multifarious Industry, Ministry of Industry.
 - The recognition as IP of Iron or Steel or stipulation of IT of Iron or Steel shall apply for one year and may be extended.
 - The extension shall be done by enclosing the following documents:
 1. Import plan for one year, covering quantity, kinds of goods, tariff heading/ HS 10 (ten) digits and destination port;
 2. Industry, Ministry of Industry, in the case of the kind and/or quantity of the would-be imported goods exceeding the previous year.

- (g) In the case of non-automatic import licensing procedures, indication of the measure being implemented through the licensing procedure; and

- (h) Expected duration of the licensing procedure if this can be estimated with some probability, and if not, reason why this information cannot be provided:

This regulation shall come into force as from the date of stipulation and expire on December 2010

Application for securing the appointment as IT of Certain Products shall be submitted in writing to the Director by enclosing the following copy documents of:

- a. Importer Identity Number (API);
- b. Corporate Registry Number (TDP);
- c. Taxpayer Code Number (NPWP);
- d. Special Importer Identity Number (NPIK) for certain products whose import is subject to provision regarding NPIK;

- e. Customs Identity Number (NIK);
 - f. Import plan for one year, covering quantity, kinds of goods, tariff heading/HS 10 (ten) digits and destination port.
- (g) In the case of non-automatic import licensing procedures, indication of the measure being implemented through the licensing procedure:
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- (h) Expected duration of the licensing procedure if this can be estimated with some probability, and if not, reason why this information cannot be provided:

The stipulation as IT of Certain Products shall apply until the expiration of this regulation.
