AGREEMENT ON IMPORT LICENSING PROCEDURES

Notification under Article 5

PAPUA NEW GUINEA

The following communication, dated 6 February 1998, has been received from the delegation of Papua New Guinea.

Papua New Guinea has abolished all import licensing procedures according to its commitments and obligations under its Membership in APEC and the WTO. The only import restrictions currently in place are those that affect health- and security-related imports, which means that these products are being regulated for national security and health reasons. Apart from that, there are no import licensing measures in place now.
