REPLIES TO QUESTIONNAIRE ON IMPORT LICENSING PROCEDURES

Notification under Article 7.3 of the Agreement on Import Licensing Procedures

PERU

The following notification, dated 30 December 1998, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Peru.

The Permanent Representation of Peru wishes to reiterate the content of its notification in document G/LIC/N/3/PER/1 of 27 August 1996 to the effect that no administrative procedure relating to import licensing exists in Peru. Legislative Decree No. 668 repealed, in 1991, the licences, opinions, prior approvals, import register and other prior conditions.

Hence, questions 1 to 18 of the Questionnaire on Import Licensing Procedures (G/LIC/3, Annex) do not apply to Peru.

With regard to question 19, on the availability of foreign exchange, the Permanent Representation of Peru wishes to state that in Peru the State guarantees the freedom of natural and legal persons resident in the country to possess, use and dispose of foreign currency both internally and externally (Article 5 of Legislative Decree No. 668).
