

**NOTIFICATION OF REPLIES TO THE QUESTIONNAIRE ON IMPORT  
LICENSING PROCEDURES FROM OMAN**

Questions from the UNITED STATES to OMAN<sup>1</sup>

The following communication, dated 10 May 2001, has been received from the Permanent Mission of the United States.

---

In G/LIC/N/1/OMN/1, dated 20 February 2001, Oman has notified Ministerial Decision No.71/2000 on Import Licensing Procedures. Thus is Oman's first notification to the Committee since its accession to the WTO in November 2000.

- We note that Oman has not submitted responses to the Import Licensing Questionnaire. Does this signify that Oman has no import licensing restrictions?
  - Does Oman regulate the import of products with health and security implications e.g. explosives, armaments, narcotics? Are these products regulated with a system of prior import authorizations? If so, we suggest that Oman respond to the questionnaire on these items.
