**CONSOLIDATED TARIFF SCHEDULES DATABASE FORMATS FOR TARIFF
COMMITMENTS AND SPECIFIC COMMITMENTS IN AGRICULTURE
IN HS2002 NOMENCLATURE**

Approved by the Committee on 11 October 2010

This document¹ presents a revised version of the formats that will be used in the Consolidated Tariff Schedules (CTS) database for all Members' tariff commitments, as well as for specific commitments in agriculture, pursuant to the introduction of the HS 2002 changes in the Members' schedules of concessions (See Decision of 15 February 2005 – WT/L/605).

The revised formats presented in this document will be used in the new version of the CTS in HS 2002 nomenclature. It is worth recalling that the original formats for the CTS database tables were included in documents G/MA/63 concerning the Consolidated Tariff Schedule Database Technical Co-operation Project and G/MA/110 including the formats for Members' specific commitments in agriculture.

The revised formats include information on commitments contained in the Schedules under:

- Part I - Section I-A - Tariffs
 Section I-B - Tariff Quotas
 Section II - Other Products
- Part III Non-Tariff Measures
- Part IV Commitments Limiting Subsidization:
 - Section I - Domestic Support - Total AMS Commitments,
 - Section II - Export Subsidies - Budgetary Outlay and Quantity Reduction Commitments and,
 - Section III - Commitments Limiting the Scope of Export Subsidies.

The formats adopted are described in the Annexes to this document .

Concession Table

The data recorded in Table Concession represent the body of the CTS database. The tariff elements reported in the Schedules (Part I, Section 1A and Part I, Section II) are included in this table. Compared to the previous version, this table also includes unbound non-agricultural tariff lines.

Field Name	Field Description
Member	Three-digit numeric code of the WTO Member.
HS version	Indicates the version of the HS nomenclature of the commitment in the CTS file (e.g. H1=HS92; H2=HS96; H3=HS02).
TL	The customs tariff line number, heading or sub-heading associated with the product including unbound tariff lines.
TLLevel (Tariff line level)	This element is used to define the hierarchical structure of the schedule's nomenclature in the database. It is used in conjunction with the tariff line to uniquely identify each tariff line. Values are: 2 - 6 HS 2-digit through HS 6-digit headings 7 - 998 Other headings according to the hierarchy of the schedule 999 Tariff line
TLS (Tariff line suffix)	This data element is used to number Ex-outs. The TLS for sub-item record the values "01" to "99" and, for the principal item "00".
Ex	Indicates that the concession pertains to part of the tariff line or HS code or the concessions are at different duty levels or bindings.
Sector	The codes are: Ag = Standard definition of agriculture used by the Secretariat based on Annex 1 of the Agreement on Agriculture; Null = Other Products; Ag-ex = Part Agriculture and part Other Products – for chapters and headings may be required when separating the two sectors.
Hierarchy	A text string to record the sequence of tariff lines and headers as they were in the original Schedule. It is composed of the TL and TLS of the current record plus a 2-digit extra code.
Description	Product Descriptions relating to the WCO HS headings and subheadings and to the customs tariff lines, headings and subheadings in English, French or Spanish.
Certified	A flag to indicate whether the concession has been certified. C = Certified; blank = Not certified.
Source	This element indicates the source of the concession (pre-UR, UR, HS96, HS02, ITA, rectifications, etc).
Present Instrument	Legal instrument containing the present concession, e.g. UR/94 for the Uruguay Round.
First Instrument	Legal instruments containing the previous concession(s). E.g. G/47, T/51.
Base Duty AV	<i>Ad valorem</i> duty rate used as the base rate in the most recent negotiations.
Base Duty Other	Specific, mixed, compound or other base duty containing a specific element (currency and quantity unit included), where applicable – see examples under Base Duty Nature below.
Base Duty Binding Status	B = Bound; U = Unbound.
Base Duty Nature	A (<i>ad valorem</i>) – examples: 30%; 11.75% M (mixed) – examples: 10% or \$2/kg whichever is the higher (lower) C (compound) – examples: 10% + \$2/kg; 2.5% + 10 Euros/litre S (specific) - examples: \$2/kg; 0.6 Euros/% vol/hl + 4 Euros/hl O other textual duty.
Bound Duty AV	Bound <i>ad valorem</i> duty of the latest concession.
Bound Duty Other	Specific, mixed or compound duty or other bound duty containing a specific rate or textual element (currency and quantity unit included) relating to the latest concession – see examples under Base Duty Nature above.

Earlier INR Text	Initial negotiating rights on earlier concession(s) and, if available, the duty level and reference on historic INRs. E.g. CH 10 T/51-EEC6 20-US (2 or 3 alpha ISO or other codes, separated by a hyphen or comma).
Implementation From	Implementation period of the present concession: Start year.
Implementation To	Implementation period of the present concession: End year.
OTC	Other terms and conditions (OTC) relating to the individual concessions as presented in the Schedules.
Member Comments	Comments by the Member relating to the individual concessions.
Secretariat Comments	Comments of a technical nature by the Secretariat relating to the individual concessions.

Table TQ1 - Quantities

Information on tariff quotas (TQs) would be presented in two separate but linked tables. The first table sets out information applying at the level of the tariff quota itself (description, initial and final quantities, units, implementation dates, other terms and conditions, the source and present instrument of the concession (usually the Uruguay Round Schedules)). The OTC field for other terms and conditions would include information on country allocations of tariff quotas. The second table contains the tariff line information for each tariff quota. The Concession Concordance Table would be required for those Members that record the in-quota duties and over-quota duties under different tariff lines.

Field Name	Field Description
Member	Three-digit numeric code of the WTO Member.
HS version	A code indicating the version of the HS nomenclature of the commitment in the CTS file. E.g. H1 = HS92; H2 = HS96; H3 = HS02.
TQ ID	Indicates the number of the tariff quota for each Member in the same order as in the relevant Schedules. This number can be used to see the different number of tariff quotas for each Member and is the link to the in-quota duties in Table TQ2. The seven-character code is comprised of the three-letter WTO Member code, followed by "Q" for "quota", followed by the three-digit number representing the tariff quota's place in the relevant Schedule.
Type of Access	In some Schedules, the tariff quota commitments are presented according to the type of access (current, minimum or non-tariffed). Values could be "C" for current access commitments, "M" for minimum access commitments and "N" for non-tariffed access commitments. For Members that have not shown their tariff quotas by type of access, the column would contain a null value representing "Not applicable".
Description	Product description of the tariff quota taken from the Schedules.
Certified	A flag to indicate whether the concession has been certified. C = Certified; blank = Not certified.
Source	This element indicates the source of the concession (pre-UR, UR, HS96, HS02, ITA, rectifications, etc).
Present Instrument	Legal instrument containing the present concession, e.g. UR/94 for the Uruguay Round.
First Instrument	Legal instruments containing the previous concession(s). E.g. G/47, T/51.
Initial Quantity	The initial tariff quota quantity as shown in each Member's Schedule.
Final Quantity	The final tariff quota quantity as shown in each Member's Schedule.
Unit	The unit in which the tariff quota quantity is denominated in the Schedule of the Member concerned.
Implementation From	Start year of the implementation period. This would refer to the quantity commitments. The implementation period in Table TQ2 would apply to the in-quota duties.
Implementation To	End year when the final concession is implemented. This refers to the quantity commitments while the implementation period in Table TQ2 applies to the in-quota duties.
Present INR Text	WTO Member(s) holding Initial Negotiating Rights (INRs) on the present concession.
Earlier INR Text	Initial negotiating rights on earlier concession(s) and, if available, the duty level and reference on historic INRs. E.g. CH 10 T/51-EEC6 20-US (2 or 3 alpha ISO or other codes, separated by a hyphen or comma).
OTC	Other terms and conditions (OTCs) applicable to this tariff quota including trading partner quantity allocations as presented in the Schedules.
Member Comments	Comments by the Member on any of the elements at the tariff quota level.
Secretariat Comments	Comments of a technical nature by the WTO Secretariat on any of the elements at the tariff quota level.

Table TQ2 - Tariffs

The second table presents tariff quota information. While the first pertained to information applying at the level of the tariff quota itself, this second table would set out the specific HS tariff lines with base and bound in-quota duties that are included within each tariff quota. The source and present instrument of the concession would also be indicated here. The source would usually be the Uruguay Round Schedule, but could be different from that recorded in Table TQ1, if amended for example, through the HS96 transposition process.

Field Name	Field Description
Member	Three-digit numeric code of the WTO Member.
HS version	A code indicating the version of the HS nomenclature of the commitment in the CTS file. E.g. H1 = HS92; H2 = HS96; H3 = HS02.
TQ ID	Indicates the number of the tariff quota for each Member in the same order as in the relevant Schedule. This field is the link to Table TQ1 and indicates to which tariff quota each tariff line belongs.
TL	The tariff line or heading associated with the tariff quota concession.
TLS	Tariff line suffix. In the Concession Table, the TL and TLS combination is used to uniquely identify a tariff concession. For cases where the tariff suffix is recorded, this data element combined with the TL could be used to link the tariff quota to the over-quota tariffs in the Concession Table. When the over-quota tariffs are recorded under different tariff lines than the in-quota tariffs, the Concession Concordance Table would be used to establish the link to the over-quota tariff line.
Ex	Indicates that the concession pertains to part of the tariff line or heading. The Ex field is for printing while the TLS field combined with the TL field is used for linking to other tables.
Description	If applicable, description of the product as recorded in the Schedules.
Certified	A flag to indicate whether the concession has been certified. C = Certified; blank = Not certified.
Source	This element indicates the source of the concession (pre-UR, UR, HS96, HS02, ITA, rectifications, etc).
Present Instrument	Legal instrument containing the present concession, e.g. UR/94 for the Uruguay Round.
First Instrument	Legal instruments containing the previous concession(s). E.g. G/47, T/51.
Base Duty - <i>Ad valorem</i>	<i>Ad valorem</i> duty applying to the initial quota quantity, if applicable. "Free" is represented as 0 in this field.
Base Duty - Other	Duty applying to the initial tariff quota quantity, other than <i>ad valorem</i> (i.e., specific, compound, mixed, etc.). Duties that are comprised of an <i>ad valorem</i> part and a specific part (e.g. "10% plus 5\$ per kilo") would be recorded as a text string in this field. The <i>ad valorem</i> part of the duty would not be recorded under the base duty - <i>ad valorem</i> field.
Base Duty Nature	Nature of the base duty. Codes are: A (<i>ad valorem</i>), M (mixed), C (compound), S (specific) or O (other).
Bound Duty - <i>Ad valorem</i>	<i>Ad valorem</i> duty applying to the final quota quantity, if applicable. "Free" is represented as 0 in this field.
Bound Duty - Other	Duty applying to the final tariff quota quantity other than <i>ad valorem</i> (i.e., specific, compound, etc.). Duties that are comprised of an <i>ad valorem</i> part and a specific part (e.g. "10% plus 5\$ per kilo") would be recorded as a text string in this field. The <i>ad valorem</i> part of the duty would not be recorded under the bound duty - <i>ad valorem</i> field.
Bound Duty Nature	Nature of the bound duty. Codes are: A (<i>ad valorem</i>), M (mixed), C (compound), S (specific) or O (other).
Implementation From	Start year of the implementation period.
Implementation To	End year when the final concession is implemented.

OTC	Other information applicable to this tariff line as presented in the Schedules. Terms and conditions pertaining to the tariff quota as a whole can be found in Table TQ1.
Member Comments	Comments by the Member on any of the elements for the tariff line.

Concession Concordance Table

This table would be required for tariff quotas. It would be used to link the in-quota tariff lines in Table TQ2 with the over-quota tariff lines in the Concession Table. It would only be required for those Members that have assigned different tariff line numbers for the in-quota duties and the over-quota duties in their current WTO Schedules.

This table displays Total Aggregate Measurement of Support (Total AMS) commitments from Part IV Section I of Members' Schedules. The original format of the table was revised to display each Member's information on consecutive lines instead of a single row.
