# Regional Development

The purpose of the Regional Development initiatives is to facilitate the development of up to date regional framework conditions.

In addition to the Danish Enterprise and Construction Authority and the European Commission the local/regional authorities plays an important role in the administration and in financing the activities. Activities are thus often funded by a number of sources.

For that very reason it is not possible to state the average subsidy level.

The legal basis of the initiatives is the Government's Budget Proposal as adopted by the Parliament, Trade and Industrial Development Act and the Act on administration concerning ERDF & ESF subsidies and national Danish co-financing.

Almost all of the subsidies provided by Danish sources co-finance ERDF & ESF schemes (European Regional Development Fund & European Social Fund). The criteria for funding are thus mainly determined by the relevant EU programmes.

The subsidies are given as grants to individuals, companies, institutions and local authorities.

It is not possible to state a maximum limit for subsidies for each project as it depends on the amount that the companies are willing to contribute and the character of the initiative. The specific conditions which have to be fulfilled for each project vary from initiative to initiative.

It is not possible immediately to estimate the business effects of the subsidies, because it is a question of horizontal initiatives, which are not restricted to specific industries.

#### **Business Development**

The general aim of the Trade and Industrial Development Act is to strengthen the trade and industrial development in Denmark. This is primarily carried out by developing the general framework conditions for the companies.

The purpose of the Business Development initiatives is to facilitate the establishment of new companies, strengthen the development of competence and competitiveness in Danish companies.

The means to achieve these goals are a number of general/horizontal business promoting initiatives. The initiatives cover general activities concerning information; guidance and counselling

aimed at all persons that intend to become entrepreneurs and activities promoting entrepreneurship. The initiatives also cover activities concerning development of competence.

Most of the funds are granted to public authorities, independent private institutions and companies providing the services and development activities. Direct subsidies for individual companies own projects only play a very limited role as an instrument.

The legal basis of the initiatives is the Government's Budget Proposal as adopted by the Parliament and the Trade and Industrial Development Act.

The period of validity for the individual initiatives differs. Every year it is considered whether/at what level funding should be provided for individual initiatives and schemes. It is applied as a general principle that public funds shall be used as a catalyst for the development of new business promoting facilities rather than as a permanent source of finance.

It is not possible immediately to estimate the business effects of the subsidies as they represent general horizontal initiatives that are not restricted to specific industries.
