## SUBSIDIES

### New and Full Notification Pursuant to Article XVI:1 of the GATT 1994 and Article 25 of the Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures

## SOUTH AFRICA

The following communication, dated 11 August 2003, has been received from the Permanent Mission of South Africa.

With reference to the understanding reached by the Committee on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures at its 31 May 2001 special meeting (G/SCM/M/30, para. 6), and the invitation to submit new and full notifications (G/SCM/N/95 of 18 February 2003), South Africa wishes to notify the Committee as follows:

In accordance with Article 25.2 of the Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures and Article XVI:1 of the GATT 1994, the Government of South Africa wishes to inform WTO Members that South Africa does not grant or maintain within its territory any subsidy within the meaning of Article 1.1 of the Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures which is specific within the meaning of Article 2 of the Agreement, or which operates directly or indirectly to increase exports from or reduce imports into its territory within the meaning of Article XVI:1 of the GATT 1994.
