Description of content: This Order of the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Consumer Protection provides some protection measures against the outbreak of Epizootic Aphtha disease (Foot and Mouth disease) in Bahrain, Manama city, stopping the import of live animals as cattle, pigs, sheep and goats, and stopping the import of meat and not processed milk from Bahrain, Manama city to the territory of Albania. The processed meat and milk products have the entry permission to the territory of Albania when they fulfil the following conditions: (a) to be originated from non-affected area by Epizootic Aphtha disease; (b) to be processed only from factories designated and allowed to export; (c) the manufacture technology conditions have the capability to destroy the Epizootic Aphtha virus. The Veterinary Certificate of Bahrain guarantees their origin and confirms the above mentioned conditions (a), (b) and (c) of this Order. The measures also consist in stopping the import of animal feeding products that contain products from animal origin; stopping the import of biological materials from Bahrain, Manama city to the territory of Albania.

The objective is to protect human and animal health in the territory of Albania from the Epizootic Aphtha disease outbreak in Bahrain.
