Importation of Hatching (fertile) Duck Eggs from Approved Countries

Australia's Director of Animal and Plant Quarantine has determined a revised policy for the importation of the hatching (fertile) duck eggs from approved countries. A draft policy review was issued in March 2009 for public comment (G/SPS/N/AUS/230 of 27 March 2009). The key change has been a reduction in the post-hatch quarantine period from 12 to 9 weeks.

Approved countries are the United States, the United Kingdom, France, Canada, Netherlands, Germany, Ireland and New Zealand. A copy of the revised policy is available from the Biosecurity Australia website: http://www.daff.gov.au/ba.
