The following communication, received on 26 August 2011, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of <u>Australia</u>.

Final non-regulated risk analysis report for table grapes from the Republic of Korea

Biosecurity Australia has completed this policy review in response to the market access request for table grapes from the Republic of Korea into Australia. The final report proposes a combination of risk management measures and operational systems that will reduce the risk associated with the importation of table grapes from the Republic of Korea to achieve Australia's appropriate level of protection.

The report recommends that the importation of table grapes from the Republic of Korea be permitted, subject to a range of quarantine conditions including mitigation measures for Kanzawa spider mite, harlequin ladybird, scarab beetles (two species), spotted wing drosophila, grapevine phylloxera, mealybugs (two species), tortricid moths (two species), apple heliodinid, thrips, grape cluster black rot and grapevine leaf rust.

The draft non-regulated risk analysis report was published on the Biosecurity Australia website on 13 April 2011 for a 60-day stakeholder consultation period and was published as an SPS notification with reference number G/SPS/N/AUS/262 on 14 April 2011.
