The following communication, received on 22 July 2008, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of Canada.

Establishment of MRLs Previously Published in the *Canada Gazette*, Part I (1396 – Fenhexamid)

An established maximum residue limit (MRL) document entitled *Transitioning the Legal Establishment of Maximum Residue Limits (MRLs) for Pesticides from the Food and Drugs Act to the Pest Control Products Act: Establishment of MRLs Previously Published in the Canada Gazette, Part I* (EMRL2008-01) was published by the Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) on 9 July 2008.

This document establishes an MRL for fenhexamid in or on tomatoes, which had previously been consulted upon via G/SPS/N/CAN/188/Rev.1 (dated 7 April 2005).

No concerns or issues were identified by Canada's trading partners as a result of the consultation.

The establishment of MRLs as per this regulatory amendment is an enabling measure as it allows the sale of foods containing residues of the pesticide up to the levels defined by their MRLs, in accordance with EMRL2008-01. The MRL documented herein is legally in effect as of 9 July 2008, the publication date of EMRL2008-01.
