<b>6. Description of content:</b> Amendment to Resolution No. 1.011 of 2004 "Phytosanitary requirements for the importation into Chile of forage and grass seeds", as follows: I. In the table under Article 1, the entry for the species <i>Buchloe dactyloides</i> , "Seeds have been treated against <i>Tilletia buchleana</i> with any of the following fungicides on an alternating basis: Benomyl, Thiram, Carbendazim, Thiabendazole or another suitable product", has been replaced by the following: "No additional declarations required". II. The following paragraphs have been deleted from the table under Article 1: 1. The second paragraph of the entry for the species <i>Lupinus albus</i> , <i>L. angustifolius</i> , <i>L. parviflorus</i> and <i>Lupinus luteus</i> : "Seeds have been treated against <i>Diaporthe woodii</i> with any of the following fungicides on an alternating basis: Benomyl, Carboxin, Thiabendazole, Benomyl + Thiram, Carbendazim or another suitable product"; 2. The second paragraph of the entry for the species <i>Medicago sativa</i> , <i>M. polymorpha</i> and <i>M. truncatula</i> var. <i>truncatula</i> : "The consignment is free from <i>Apion tenue</i> (Col. Apionidae)";

<p>3. The second paragraph of the entry for the species <i>Trifolium</i> spp.: "The consignment is free from <i>Apion africanus</i>, <i>Apion aestivum</i> and <i>Apion virens</i> (Col. Apionidae)".</p>
