Addendum

The following communication, dated 19 April 2005, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the Republic of Korea.

Revision of Quarantine Requirements of the Wood Packaging Materials for Imported Consignments

The National Plant Quarantine Service, Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry of the Republic of Korea has modified the Quarantine Requirements of the Wood Packaging Materials for Imported Consignments as follows:

Wood Packaging Materials(WPM) entering Korea should be treated and certified in accordance with the standard established in the ISPM No.15.

As for Wood Packaging Materials(WPM) made of *Pinus spp.*, *Larix spp.*, *Cedrus spp.* from Japan, China, Taiwan, US, Canada, Mexico, Portugal and WPM made of *Pinus spp.* from Vietnam, the heat treatment in accordance with the standard in the ISPM No. 15 or Methyl Bromide Fumigation according to the following conditions should be carried out.

Temperature	Dosage(g/m ³)	Minimum concentration(g/m ³) at:
		24hrs.
21°C or above	48	24
16°C or above	56	28
11°C or above	64	32

* The minimum temperature should not be less than 10°C and the minimum exposure time should be 24hrs.

These requirements are to be effective for the consignments shipped on and after 1 June 2005 in the exporting country.
