The following communication, dated 5 October 2004, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the United States.

Products using the pesticide octanal

This final rule establishes a tolerance exemption for 1-octanal with a limitation in the pesticide formulation of not more than 0.2%.

This regulation is effective 30 September 2004. Objections and requests for hearings, identified by docket ID number OPP-2004-0298, must be received on or before 29 November 2004.
