### Addendum

The following communication, dated 12 March 2001, has been received from the United States.

---

#### Butene, Homopolymer; Tolerance Exemption

This regulation establishes an exemption from the requirement of a tolerance for residues of butene, homopolymer; when used as an inert ingredient in or on growing crops, when applied to raw agricultural commodities after harvest, or to animals. The petitioner submitted a petition to EPA under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act of 1996 requesting an exemption from the requirement of a tolerance. This regulation eliminates the need to establish a maximum permissible level for residues of butene, homopolymer.

This regulation is effective 12 March 2001. Objections and requests for hearings must be received by EPA on or before 11 May 2001.
