Addendum

The following communication, dated 19 April 2001, has been received from the United States.

Hexythiazox - Pesticide Tolerances

This regulation (final rule on G/SPS/N/USA/374) establishes tolerances for residues of the ovicide/miticide hexythiazox (trans-5- (4-chlorophenyl)-N-cyclohexyl-4-methyl-2-oxothiazolidine-3-carboxamide) and its metabolites containing the (4-chlorophenyl)-4-methyl-2-oxo-3-thiazolidine moiety (expressed as parent) in or on tree nuts (nutmeat), plums, fresh prunes, dried prunes, pistachios, peppermint (tops), spearmint (tops), and caneberries. The petitioners requested this tolerance under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA), as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act (FQPA) of 1996.

This regulation is effective 18 April 2001.

Objections and requests for hearings must be received by EPA on or before 18 June 2001.
