The following communication, dated 8 February 1999, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Fiji.

I. ENUMERATION OF STATE TRADING ENTERPRISES

STE: Fiji Sugar Corporation (FSC)
Product(s): Raw Sugar and Molasses

II. REASON AND PURPOSE FOR INTRODUCING AND MAINTAINING FSC

The FSC was established to develop and manage Fiji's sugar industry including all aspects of production and marketing.

- FSC was incorporated by an Act of Parliament in 1972 to take over all milling activities in the industry.
- Under the Sugar Industry Tribunal Master award, the FSC is responsible for the marketing of sugar and molasses.

III. DESCRIPTION OF THE FUNCTIONING OF THE FSC

- The FSC is engaged in the export of raw sugar and molasses through its marketing arm, the Fiji Sugar Marketing Company Limited (FSM).
- Under the Master Award, the FSC has exclusive rights to export raw sugar and molasses.
- Sugar is exported to the UK under the Sugar Protocol (LOME Convention). Exports to Malaysia are made under a bilateral agreement, while exports to Finland and Portugal are under Special Preferential Sugar (SPS) arrangement. Shipments to the

US are made under the US global quota arrangement. Quantities and prices are either set under these agreements, or are on world market terms.

- Sugar is also exported to Japan, China, Singapore and the Republic of Korea on world market terms.
