NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 5.1 OF THE AGREEMENT ON
TRADE-RELATED INVESTMENT MEASURES

Egypt

The following communication, dated 29 September 1995, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Egypt.

Egypt has no local content laws or regulations. However, Egypt has certain incentives in the form of custom duties reductions to promote the establishment and development of industries in the country. It is aimed at facilitating the exploitation of available resources, transfer of technology and to remedy the chronic trade balance deficit.

The customs duties incentives are voluntary, i.e. left open for enterprises which elect to benefit from such incentives.

This notification is without prejudice to Egypt's rights and obligations under GATT 1994.
