## NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 22 OF THE AGREEMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION OF ARTICLE VII OF THE GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE 1994

## **PERU**

The following communication, dated 22 October 2010, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Peru.

The Permanent Mission of Peru to the World Trade Organization, pursuant to the provisions of the Agreement on Implementation of Article VII of the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade 1994, as well as the last paragraph of Article 5 of the Agreement on Preshipment Inspection, hereby notifies the following amendments to Peru's legislation on customs valuation:

The provisions governing preshipment inspection of imports to Peru have been repealed by Article 2 of Law No. 27973, in effect since May 2004. The following legislation, notified in documents G/VAL/N/1/PER/1 and G/VAL/N/1/PER/2, is accordingly repealed:

- Supreme Decree No. 187-99-EF providing for the implementation of the WTO Agreement on Customs Valuation by surveillance companies; and
- Supreme Decree No. 157-2001-EF amending the Regulation on offences and sanctions applicable to surveillance companies.
