Addendum

The present document reproduces the updated information on the Czech Republic's technical and financial cooperation activities relevant to the implementation of the TRIPS Agreement, which has been received from the Permanent Mission of the Czech Republic by means of a communication dated 22 October 2003.

Pursuant to Article 67 of the TRIPS Agreement, the Council for TRIPS has requested developed and other countries to provide details of their technical cooperation, which they make available in the area of intellectual property rights relevant to the implementation of the TRIPS Agreement. This report describes the activity of the Industrial Property Office of the Czech Republic in the field of technical cooperation in the year 2003.

The Industrial Property Office of the Czech Republic cooperated in the organization of the **WIPO Regional Consultation on Intellectual Property and the Internet**, which took place on 30 June-1 July 2003 in Prague.

The above-mentioned seminar was focused on the following **topics** (presented by speakers from the WIPO):

- Intellectual Property and the Internet: A Survey of Issues from WIPO's Perspective;
- Digital Copyright, including the WIPO Internet Treaties;
- Trademark Issues on the Internet, including the WIPO Joint Recommendation;
- The Domain Name System and Intellectual Property;
- The Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (UDPR), the WIPO Arbitration and Mediation Centre and the Second WIPO Process.
