Constitution of the Panel

Note by the Secretariat

- 1. At its meeting on 21 September 2010, the Dispute Settlement Body (DSB) referred this dispute, if possible, to the original Panel in accordance with Article 21.5 of the Dispute Settlement Understanding (DSU) to examine the matter referred to the DSB by Mexico in document WT/DS344/20.
- 2. The terms of reference are the following:

"To examine, in the light of the relevant provisions of the covered agreements cited by the parties to the dispute, the matter referred to the DSB by Mexico in document WT/DS344/20 and to make such findings as will assist the DSB in making the recommendations or in giving the rulings provided for in those agreements".

3. Due to the unavailability of one of the original panel member, the parties agreed on a replacement panelist. The Panel was composed on 13 May 2011 as follows:
