Status Report on the Implementation of the Recommendations and Rulings
in the Dispute regarding
Japan – Measures Affecting Agricultural Products

Pursuant to Article 21.6 of the Understanding on Rules and Procedures Governing the Settlement of Disputes (DSU), the Government of Japan (GOJ) informs the Dispute Settlement Body (DSB) on the status of the implementation of the Recommendations of the DSB regarding "Japan – Measures Affecting Agricultural Products". Since this matter will be placed on the agenda of the DSB on 1 February 2001, the GOJ presents its twelfth status report as follows:

The Governments of Japan and the United States have been consulting in a constructive and friendly manner. Japan expects that Japan and the United States will reach a mutually satisfactory solution in the near future.
