Submission of Documentation

Schedule LXXXIV - Bolivia

The following communication, dated 23 November 1995, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Bolivia.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Bolivia to the United Nations Office and Other International Organizations at Geneva presents its compliments to the Director-General of the World Trade Organization and has the honour to submit herewith the following documents¹, with the purpose of carrying out the transposition of the concessions negotiated by Bolivia in the course of its accession to GATT, as set forth in Schedule LXXXIV, into the Harmonized System nomenclature, in accordance with the procedures for negotiations under Article XXVIII (BISD 27S/26) and the Decision of the Council of 12 July 1983 (BISD 30S/17). It also requests that they be circulated to Members of the WTO.

Annex I: Existing Schedule

Schedule LXXXIV - Bolivia, submitted in the NABANDINA nomenclature, is contained in the Protocol for the Accession of Bolivia to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade dated 16 August 1989.

Annex II: Proposed Schedule LXXXIV

The Proposed Schedule reflects all the existing bindings that are based on the Common Nomenclature of the Andean Pact (NANDINA), and no bound tariff has been changed.

Annex III: Concordance Table from the Existing Schedule to the Proposed Schedule

The Concordance Table provides a cross-reference between the NABANDINA and NANDINA nomenclatures.

Annex IV: Concordance Table from the Proposed Schedule to the Existing Schedule

Members wishing to hold consultations concerning the concessions included in Schedule LXXXIV should transmit a written communication to that effect to the Mission of Bolivia, with a copy to the WTO Secretariat, within a period of 90 days from the date of this document. Where possible, the communication should mention the products and tariff heading numbers concerned.
