Final report

Report by the delegation of Sri Lanka relating to negotiations under Article XXVIII with respect to Schedule VI concerning the transposition of its tariff schedule, previously established in the CCCN Nomenclature, to the Harmonized System³.

1. Negotiations resulted in agreement with:

2. Agreement was not reached with:

3. Consultations have been held with:

Consultations were held with Australia, the EC, New Zealand, South Africa and the United States following reservations filed by these countries with respect to notification SECRET/HS/26 of 12 January 1990. The notified bilateral agreements embody the results of these negotiations. South Africa has withdrawn its reservations.

Since no other WTO Member expressed its interest to enter into negotiations, Sri Lanka considers its negotiations under GATT Article XXVIII to be completed.
