**NOTIFICATION OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS UNDER

**QUESTIONS FROM THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC REGARDING
THE NOTIFICATION OF ECUADOR¹**

The following communication, dated 4 October 2019, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of the Dominican Republic.

Questions

Article 56.2 of Ecuadorian Resolution No. 10-2018 on requirements and procedures for dumping investigations and the application of anti-dumping measures states that the Investigating Authority may request public institutions or state entities to support on-the-spot investigations. In this regard, we ask Ecuador to reply to the following questions:

- (i) What type of support may be provided by public institutions for on-the-spot investigations?
 - (ii) Does such cooperation involve the presence of a technician from these public institutions during the verification visits carried out by the Investigating Authority?
