Revision

The following is the WTO list of developing countries eligible as beneficiaries in respect of the measures provided for within the framework of the Decision, revised to include Tonga as decided at the meeting of the Committee on Agriculture on 27-28 March 2023:

- a. least-developed countries as recognized by the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations; plus
- b. Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, Botswana, Côte d'Ivoire, Cuba, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Egypt, El Salvador, Eswatini, Gabon, Grenada, Honduras, Jamaica, Jordan, Kenya, Maldives, Mauritius, Mongolia, Morocco, Namibia, Pakistan, Peru, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Samoa, Senegal, Sri Lanka, Trinidad and Tobago, Tonga, Tunisia and the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela.¹
