COMPLIANCE WITH NOTIFICATION OBLIGATIONS

NOTE BY THE SECRETARIAT¹

Revision

The present document has been prepared to assist the consideration of agenda item "overdue notifications" during the November 2016 meeting of the Committee on Agriculture. It reflects Members' compliance with their regular notification obligations as of 28 October 2016.²

In preparing this overview, the Secretariat has largely relied on the Agriculture Information Management System (AG-IMS).³

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
1 NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1.1. There are a total of twelve distinct notification requirements applicable in the domain of agriculture covering the following five areas: (i) Market access (Tables MA:1 to MA:5), (ii) Domestic support (Tables DS:1 to DS:2), (iii) Export subsidies (Tables ES:1 to ES:3), (iv) Export prohibitions or restrictions (Table ER:1), and (v) Follow-up to the Marrakesh NFIDC Decision (Table NF:1). The applicability of a notification requirement to a Member is largely dependent on the specific commitments it has assumed under the Agreement on Agriculture. In many cases a limited number of notification requirements will apply for a particular Member. Simultaneously, there are a few notification requirements especially in the area of agricultural subsidization (i.e. Tables DS:1 and ES:1) that apply to all WTO Members.

1.2. Out of the twelve notification requirements, there are five "regular" or "annual" notification requirements, namely: Table MA:2, Table MA:5, Table DS:1, Table ES:1 and Table ES:2. Annual notifications are required to be submitted no later than a certain number of days following the end of the year in question. The deadlines for submission of notifications vary per type of notification and are indicated below. For additional details refer to document G/AG/2.


Figure 1: Notifications submitted to the WTO (1995-2016*)

1.3. As of 28 October 2016 a total of 3,892 agriculture notifications (including addenda, corrigenda and revision) have been submitted to the WTO. The number of notifications submitted to the WTO experienced a sharp decrease from 2002 to 2007, from the year 2008 onwards the number of notifications submitted annually increased to levels well above those present in 2007, with 2013 and 2015 being the exception (figure 1).


Figure 2: Number of years reported in regular notifications (1995-2016*)

1.4. Notifications covering multiple years have been frequently submitted by Members. Since 2009 onwards, the average number of years reported per notification has been close to three (Figure 2).

1.5. For the period 1995-2014, there are a total of 1,643 outstanding regular notifications.⁴ Out of the five annual notification requirements, Domestic Support (Table DS:1) and Export Subsidy (Table ES:1) notifications have the highest number of outstanding notifications with 36% (733 notifications) and 33% (762 notifications) of notifications pending, respectively.


Figure 3: Total outstanding notifications per type of notification requirement (1995-2014)

1.6. Figure 4 below shows the number of outstanding notifications according to the category of Members (i.e. developed country, developing country and least developed country Members -LDC-). Out of the 164 WTO Members, nine are developed country Members⁵ with 44 annual notification requirements, whereas the remaining 127 Member are developing country Members (including LDCs) with 337 annual notification requirements.

1.1 Annual Notification Obligations

1.7. The time limits for notifications covering the 1995-2014 implementation years have now passed. The seven tables contained in part 2 of this document (Compliance with annual notification obligations) show the Members' compliance with their notification requirements. The tables show only those Members to whom the notification requirement applies. The last column on each table shows the percentage of compliance by Member for the corresponding notification requirement. The tables contain information pertaining to the last 16 years (2000-2015). The column concerning the 2015 implementation year is provided for information only and does not necessarily indicate that the notifications are now due. The full time series (1995-2015) of compliance information is available in the "Compliance with notification obligations" section of the Agriculture Information Management System (<http://agims.wto.org>).

1.8. Members' compliance with their notification obligations varies greatly and compliance also varies by type of notification.⁶ Few Members are 100% compliant with all their notification requirements and there is an important percentage of Members whose compliance with some of their notification obligations is 0% (30 Members in DS:1 and 25 Members in ES:1) (Table 1).

1.1.1 Table MA:1 notifications, comprehensive one-off (Implementation of tariff and other quota commitments; Article 18.2 – 30 days)


1.9. Table MA:1 notifications are required to have been submitted by all Members with tariff and other quota commitments, either in advance or within 30 days of the first opening of the tariff quotas concerned. Subsequent changes to the administration of tariff and other quotas are included in ad-hoc Table MA:1 notifications to be made within 30 days following the change.

1.1.2 Table MA:2 notifications (Imports under tariff and other quotas; Article 18.2 – 60 days)

1.10. Table MA:2 notifications are required to be submitted annually by Members with tariff and other quota commitments specified in Section I-B (or Section I-A) of Part I of their Schedules for the products concerned.


1.11. For the period 1995-2014 there are 51 Table MA:2 notifications outstanding which represent 8% of the total MA:2 notifications expected for this period. Compliance with MA:2 notifications is among the highest. Out of the 39 Members with this notification obligation, 23 (59%) are completely up to date with their notifications, whereas 15 Members (38%) have compliance rates between 50% and 99%, and only one Member is below the 50% threshold (figure 5).

Figure 5: Compliance with MA:2 notifications, 1995-2014 (Number of Members)**1.1.3 Table MA:5 notifications (Special Safeguard; Articles 5.7 and 18.2 – 30 days)**

1.12. Table MA:5 notifications are required to be submitted annually by Members that have reserved the right to have recourse to the Special Safeguard provisions as indicated in Section I-A of Part I of their Schedules.


Figure 6: Compliance with MA:5 notifications, 1995-2014 (Number of Members)

1.13. For the period 1995-2014 there are 55 Table MA:5 notifications outstanding which represents 8% of the total MA:5 notifications expected for this period. Compliance with Table MA:5 notifications is the highest where out of 33 Members with this notification, 23 Members (70%) are completely up to date with their obligations for the reported period. Eight Members (30%) have a compliance rate between 50% and 99%, one Member has a compliance rate between 1% and 49%, while another Member has a zero compliance rate (Figure 6).

1.1.4 Table DS:1 notifications (Domestic support; Article 18.2 – 90 days or 120 days if the initial notification is provisional)

1.14. Table DS:1 notifications are required to be submitted annually by Members with base and annual commitment levels specified in Section I of Part IV of their Schedules. All other Members, except Least-Developed Country (LDC) Members, should submit an annual Table DS:1 notification.⁷ LDC Members are required to submit Supporting Tables DS:1 to DS:3 every other year (indicated by the symbol "(NA)").

1.15. For the period 1995-2014 there are 733 Table DS:1 notifications outstanding, the highest percentage of outstanding notifications from the group, which represents 36% of the total DS:1 notifications expected for this period. The compliance rates for Table DS:1 vary greatly. There are 30 Members (23%) with 100% compliance, and 30 Members (23%) with compliance rates at 0% (Figure 7).

Figure 7: Compliance with DS:1 notifications, 1995-2014 (Number of Members)




1.1.5 Table ES:1 notifications (Export subsidies; Article 18.2 – 60 days or 120 days if the initial notification is provisional)

1.16. Table ES:1 notifications are required to be submitted annually by Members with base and annual commitment levels specified in Section II of Part IV of their Schedules. Members with no such scheduled commitments are required to submit an annual notification (within 30 days following the end of the year in question) in the form of a statement confirming that no export subsidies exist or, in the case of developing country Members using certain export subsidies pursuant to Article 9.4, in the form of Supporting Table ES:2.


1.17. For the period 1995-2014 there are 762 Table ES:1 notifications outstanding which represents 33% of the total ES:1 notifications expected for this period. Like Table DS:1 compliance, Table ES:1 compliance rates vary greatly. A total of 25 Members (19%) have a 0% compliance rate, whereas 46 Members (35%) have submitted all their corresponding notifications (Figure 8).

Figure 8: Compliance with ES:1 notifications, 1995-2014 (Number of Members)**1.1.6 Table ES:2 notifications (Total exports; Articles 10 and 18.2 – 120 days)**

1.18. Table ES:2 notifications are required to be submitted annually by Members with export subsidy commitments specified in Section II of Part IV of their Schedules and by "significant exporters" as listed in G/AG/2/Add.1.

1.19. For the period 1995-2014 there are 42 Table ES:2 notifications outstanding which represents 8% of the total ES:2 notifications expected for this period. Compliance with this notification requirement is also among the highest. A total of 17 Members (63%) have submitted all of their corresponding Table ES:2 notifications. Additionally, eight Members (30%) have a compliance rate between 50% and 99%. The remaining two Members (7%) have a compliance rate between 1% and 49% (Figure 9).

Figure 9: Compliance with ES:2 notifications, 1995-2014 (Number of Members)**1.2 Other Regular Notification Obligations Applicable only upon Maintenance of Specific Measures****1.2.1 Table ES:3 notifications (Food aid volumes; Articles 10 and 18.2 – 120 days)**

1.20. Table ES:3 notifications are required to be submitted annually by all food donor Members for all donated products (except for those products in respect of which this information must be

notified under Table ES:1). No "nil return" is required from Members that do not provide food aid. From 1995 to 28 October 2016, a total of 198 Table ES:3 notifications have been submitted to the WTO (including addenda, corrigenda and revisions).

1.2.2 Table NF:1 notifications (Food and other aid in the context of the Marrakesh Decision; Article 16.2 – 60 days)

1.21. Table NF:1 notifications are required by all donor Members in respect of actions taken within the framework of the Decision on Measures Concerning the Possible Negative Effects of the Reform Programme on Least-Developed and Net Food-Importing Developing Countries. No "nil return" is required from Members that do not provide food aid or other assistance to the countries concerned. From 1995 to 28 October 2016, a total of 177 Table NF:1 notifications have been submitted to the WTO (including addenda, corrigenda and revisions).

1.3 Symbols and Abbreviations

A blank space (" ") indicates that the notification is outstanding.

A hyphen ("--") indicates for Table NF:1 and Table ES:3 notifications that no notification was submitted.

A capital "x" ("X") indicates that a notification has been issued. No assessment on the content or quality of the notification with respect to requirements is made or implied.

A capital "x" followed by a superscripted star ("X*") indicates that the one-off Table MA:1 notification has been revised or supplemented.

A capital "p" ("P") indicates that a notification has been received and is either being processed or pending for want of feedback from the notifying Member. A pending notification will be marked as "P" for a maximum period of six months.

An a ("a") indicates that information concerning food aid (column 5 of Table ES:1) has not been provided.

A capital "n" and a capital "a" ("NA") indicates that the requirement was not applicable during the period covered either because there were no relevant commitments (e.g. tariff quotas) or because the Member concerned was not yet a WTO Member.

A capital "n" and a capital "a" in brackets ("(NA)") indicates that domestic support notifications are required every second year from LDC Members.

Shaded cells indicate that the Member concerned has a scheduled domestic support and/or an export subsidy reduction commitment.

EU refers to the European Union as follows: EU-15 from 1995, EU-25 from 2004, EU-27 from 2007 and EU-28 from 2013. Outstanding notifications for EU member States are presented in an Annex to Section I.

Switzerland in all tables refers to Switzerland-Liechtenstein, except in NF:1 notifications.
