NOTIFICATION

The following submission, dated 13 January 2014, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of the **Dominican Republic**. The notification concerns domestic support commitments (**Table DS:1**) for the year **2012**.

The only domestic support measures applied by the Dominican Republic in 2012, as covered by the Agreement on Agriculture, are those listed in the attached supporting table. Only subheading (a) of Supporting Table DS:1 was considered applicable in the case of the Dominican Republic (see annexes).
