The following submission, dated 21 December 2020, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of the **Kyrgyz Republic**. The notification concerns export prohibitions or restrictions (**Table ER:1**).

3 NATURE OF, AND JUSTIFICATION FOR, MEASURE TO BE INTRODUCED:

In order to prevent a critical shortage and ensure food security, including national security of the population, the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic adopted decree No. 569, dated 19 November 2020 on the introduction of a ban on the export of certain types of agricultural goods from the Republic.

According to the decision, the measure is not applied to re-export, transit and humanitarian products.

The decree of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic No. 174 dated 22 March 2020 with duration of six months is no longer in force.

The measure would also be notified to the Committee on Market access.

4 DURATION OF APPLICATION OF MEASURE:

This measure will be effective for six months, starting from the date of its entry into force on 19 November 2020.
