¹ Under the Resource Management Act 1991, most resource management responsibilities are assigned to New Zealand's 15 regional councils. As a result, the majority of resource management programmes relevant to agriculture are now carried out at the regional level. The figures given represent the total expenditure by councils on the resource management programmes, net of funds recovered from users or beneficiaries. However, not all of this expenditure benefits, or is directly attributable to agriculture. Depending on the programme, the amount of expenditure that is attributable varies between an estimated 60% to 100%.
