



## REPORT (2021) OF THE COMMITTEE ON SUBSIDIES AND COUNTERVAILING MEASURES

(ADOPTED 26 OCTOBER 2021)

### 1 ORGANIZATION OF THE WORK OF THE COMMITTEE

1. The Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures ("the Agreement") entered into force on 1 January 1995. All Members of the WTO are *ipso facto* members of the Committee on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures ("the Committee") established under the Agreement.

2. Observer governments in the General Council of the WTO have Observer status in the Committee. The IMF, World Bank, UNCTAD, and FAO have regular Observer status in the Committee. Pursuant to decisions made by the Committee in April and November 1998, respectively, the OECD and the Organization of African, Caribbean and Pacific States ("OACPS") are invited to attend meetings on an *ad hoc* basis. Requests for Observer status from the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa and the Gulf Organization for Industrial Consulting are under consideration by Members.

3. This Report covers the period 28 October 2020 – 26 October 2021 ("review period"). During the review period, the Committee held two regular and two special meetings, on 27 April<sup>1</sup> and 26 October 2021.<sup>2</sup>

4. As of the beginning of the review period, Ms Sung-yo Choi (Republic of Korea) was Chairperson and Mr Erik Philip Greger Solberg (Norway) was Vice Chairperson. On 28 July 2021, the Council for Trade in Goods ("CTG") appointed Ms Noriko Teranishi (Japan) as Chairperson of the Committee. As per the Committee's decision on 27 April 2021<sup>3</sup>, a communication was sent to the Membership in this respect on 28 July 2021 and as no written objection was received, Ms Teranishi was elected as the Chairperson of the Committee on 30 July 2021. On the Vice-Chairperson, a communication was sent on 13 September 2021 by Ms Teranishi proposing Mr Juan Carlos Estrella (Ecuador) as Vice-Chairperson. As no written objection was received, Mr Estrella was elected as the Vice-Chairperson of the Committee on 21 September 2021.

### 2 PERMANENT GROUP OF EXPERTS

5. The Committee is required by Article 24.3 of the Agreement to establish a Permanent Group of Experts ("PGE"). The tasks assigned to the PGE by the Agreement are: to provide assistance to a Panel, on request, with regard to whether a measure is a prohibited subsidy; to provide a Member with confidential advisory opinions on the nature of any subsidy proposed to be introduced or currently maintained by that Member; and to provide the Committee with advisory opinions on the existence and nature of any subsidy.

6. As of the beginning of the review period, the PGE had four members: Ms Luz Elena Reyes de la Torre (Mexico); Mr Jaemin Lee (Republic of Korea); Mr Rabih Nasser (Brazil); and Ms Marina Foltea (Republic of Moldova). The term of office of Ms Luz Elena Reyes de la Torre expired in April 2021.

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The Committee elected Ms Tomoko Ota (Japan) and Mr Donald Cameron Orth (Canada) as the new members of the PGE.

7. As of the end of the review period, the five members of the PGE are: Mr Jaemin Lee (until spring 2022); Mr Rabih Nasser (until spring 2023); Ms Marina Foltea (until spring 2024); Ms Tomoko Ota (until spring 2025); and Mr Donald Cameron Orth (until spring 2026).

### 3 NOTIFICATION OF SUBSIDIES

8. 2021 new and full notifications: In accordance with Article 25.1 of the Agreement and Article XVI of GATT 1994, all Members were required to submit new and full notifications of subsidies by 30 June 2021.<sup>4</sup> As of 26 October 2021, pursuant to these provisions, 29<sup>5</sup> Members had notified measures, and 4 Members had notified that they did not maintain any notifiable subsidies. These notifications can be found in document series G/SCM/N/372/... . A table indicating the status of 2021 notifications is provided in Annex A to this Report.

9. At its regular meeting of 27 April 2021, the Committee decided that the procedures adopted in April 2005 for the review of the 2005 new and full notifications (G/SCM/117) also would apply to the review of the 2021 new and full notifications.<sup>6</sup> Pursuant to this decision, at its special meeting held on 26 October 2021, the Committee reviewed the 2021 new and full subsidy notifications of Cambodia<sup>7</sup>; Macao, China; Montenegro; Lao People's Democratic Republic<sup>7</sup>; and Chinese Taipei.

10. 2019 new and full notifications: In accordance with Article 25.1 of the Agreement and Article XVI of GATT 1994, all Members were required to submit new and full notifications of subsidies by 30 June 2019.<sup>4</sup> As of 26 October 2021, pursuant to these provisions, 47<sup>5</sup> Members had notified measures, and 11 Members had notified that they did not maintain any notifiable subsidies. These notifications can be found in document series G/SCM/N/343/... . A table indicating the status of 2019 notifications is provided in Annex B to this Report.

11. At its special meetings held on 27 April and 26 October 2021, the Committee reviewed the 2019 notifications of Albania<sup>8</sup>; Cambodia<sup>7</sup>; Chile; Colombia<sup>8</sup>; Costa Rica; Guatemala; Honduras; Israel; Lao People's Democratic Republic<sup>7</sup>; Malaysia; Namibia<sup>8</sup>; Kingdom of Saudi Arabia; and the United States.

12. 2017 new and full notifications: In accordance with Article 25.1 of the Agreement and Article XVI of GATT 1994, all Members were required to submit new and full notifications of subsidies by 30 June 2017.<sup>4</sup> As of 26 October 2021, pursuant to these provisions, 48<sup>5</sup> Members had notified measures, and 21 Members had notified that they did not maintain any notifiable subsidies. These notifications can be found in document series G/SCM/N/315/... . A table indicating the status of 2017 notifications is provided in Annex C to this Report.

13. At its special meetings held on 27 April and 26 October 2021, the Committee reviewed the 2017 notifications of Albania<sup>8</sup>; Colombia<sup>8</sup>; and Namibia.<sup>8</sup>

14. 2015 new and full notifications: In accordance with Article 25.1 of the Agreement and Article XVI of GATT 1994, all Members were required to submit new and full notifications of subsidies by 30 June 2015.<sup>4</sup> As of 26 October 2021, pursuant to these provisions, 49<sup>5</sup> Members had notified measures, and 29 Members had notified that they did not maintain any notifiable subsidies. These notifications can be found in document series G/SCM/N/284/... . A table indicating the status of 2015 notifications is provided in Annex D to this Report.

15. At its special meetings held on 27 April and 26 October 2021, the Committee reviewed the 2015 notifications of Albania<sup>8</sup> and Namibia.<sup>8</sup>

16. 2013 new and full notifications: In accordance with Article 25.1 of the Agreement and Article XVI of GATT 1994, all Members were required to submit new and full notifications of subsidies by 30 June 2013.<sup>4</sup> As of 26 October 2021, pursuant to these provisions, 50<sup>5</sup> Members had notified measures, and 29 Members had notified that they did not maintain any notifiable subsidies, pursuant to these provisions. These notifications can be found in document series G/SCM/N/253/.... A table indicating the status of 2013 notifications is provided in Annex E to this Report.

17. At its special meetings held on 27 April and 26 October 2021, the Committee reviewed the 2013 notifications of Albania<sup>8</sup> and Namibia.<sup>8</sup>

18. 2011 new and full notifications: In accordance with Article 25.1 of the Agreement and Article XVI of GATT 1994, all Members were required to submit new and full notifications of subsidies by 30 June 2011.<sup>4</sup> As of 26 October 2021, pursuant to these provisions, 45<sup>5</sup> Members had notified measures, and 31 Members had notified that they did not maintain any notifiable subsidies, pursuant to these provisions. These notifications can be found in document series G/SCM/N/220/.... A table indicating the status of 2011 notifications is provided in Annex F to this Report.

19. At its special meetings held on 27 April and 26 October 2021, the Committee reviewed the 2011 notifications of Albania<sup>8</sup> and Namibia.<sup>8</sup>

20. At its special meetings held on 27 April and 26 October 2021, the Committee continued its reviews that had not been completed at previous meetings of 2019, 2017, 2015, 2013, 2011, and 2009 new and full notifications.

21. Annex G to this report indicates the period covered by the most recent new and full subsidy notification made by each Member.

22. Article 25.8 of the Agreement provides: "Any Member may, at any time, make a written request for information on the nature and extent of any subsidy granted or maintained by another Member (including any subsidy referred to in Part IV), or for an explanation of the reasons for which a specific measure has been considered as not subject to the requirement of notification". Information requests made under this provision are circulated in document series G/SCM/Q2/... . Some of the questions presented to date pursuant to this provision remain unanswered.

#### **4 WORKING PARTY ON SUBSIDY NOTIFICATIONS**

23. The Working Party on Subsidy Notifications did not meet during the review period.

#### **5 ARTICLE 27.4 EXTENSIONS OF THE TRANSITION PERIOD FOR THE ELIMINATION OF EXPORT SUBSIDIES**

24. Transparency notifications covering calendar year 2014 submitted pursuant to the procedures in WT/L/691, regarding extensions under Article 27.4 of the Agreement: At its special meeting held on 30 April 2019, the Committee considered transparency notification covering calendar year 2014 (the first of the two final phase-out years for the covered export subsidies) submitted by Saint Kitts and Nevis in the context of Article 27.4 extensions.<sup>9</sup> These notifications, which were due by 30 June 2015, can be found in document series G/SCM/N/290/... .

25. Final transparency notifications covering calendar year 2015 submitted pursuant to the procedures in WT/L/691, regarding Article 27.4 extensions: As of 26 October 2021, Antigua and Barbuda; Belize; Costa Rica; Dominica; Dominican Republic; El Salvador; Grenada; Guatemala; Jamaica; Jordan; Mauritius; Papua New Guinea; Saint Kitts and Nevis; Saint Lucia; and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines had submitted the final transparency notifications required by paragraph 2(c)

of the procedures in WT/L/691. These notifications were due by 30 June 2016 in respect of calendar year 2015, the final year of the two final phase-out years for the covered export subsidies<sup>10</sup> and can be found in document series G/SCM/N/299/... . The Committee considered these notifications at its 26 October 2021 regular meeting. As discussed at that meeting, this issue – including reporting by the Chair on the status of the notifications – will be on the agenda of the spring 2022 meeting.

## **6 NOTIFICATION AND EXAMINATION OF COUNTERVAILING DUTY LAWS AND/OR REGULATIONS**

26. Pursuant to Article 32.6 of the Agreement and a decision of the Committee in February 1995, all Members having new or existing legislation and/or regulations which apply in whole or in part to countervailing duty investigations or reviews covered by the Agreement are requested to notify the full and integrated text of such legislation and/or regulations to the Committee. Changes in a Member's legislation and/or regulations are also to be notified. If a Member has no such legislation or regulations, the Member is to inform the Committee of this fact. The Committee also decided that Observer governments should comply with these notification obligations.

27. As of 26 October 2021, 82 Members had notified the Committee of their domestic countervailing duty legislation<sup>11</sup>, while 35 Members had notified that they had no such legislation. These notifications can be found in document series G/SCM/N/1/.... Twenty Members had not yet made notifications under Article 32.6 of the Agreement. Annex H sets out the status of notifications under Article 32.6, and the reference symbol(s) of the document(s) containing each Member's current notification.

28. During the review period, the Committee reviewed notifications regarding countervailing duty legislation and/or regulations submitted by Argentina; Brazil; Canada; India; Peru; Saint Kitts and Nevis; Turkey; and the United States. The Committee continued the review of the legislative notifications of the following Members that have been previously reviewed by the Committee: Costa Rica; Ghana, Liberia, and Peru. In addition, pending written questions posed to the legislative notifications of the following Members remained on the agendas of the April and/or the October 2021 meetings: Bolivia, Plurinational State of; Cameroon; Ghana; Kenya; Liberia; Saint Kitts and Nevis, and the United Kingdom. Written questions and answers regarding legislative notifications can be found in document series G/SCM/Q1/....

## **7 SEMI-ANNUAL REPORTS ON COUNTERVAILING ACTIONS<sup>12</sup>**

29. Notifications for 1 July - 31 December 2020: As of 26 October 2021, 12<sup>13-14</sup> Members had notified countervailing actions taken during the period 1 July - 31 December 2020. Ninety Members (including those that submitted one-time notifications) had notified the Committee that they had not taken any countervailing action during this period. Thirty-five Members had not submitted a notification. These semi-annual reports were circulated in document series G/SCM/N/371/... and were reviewed at the Committee's regular meeting held on 27 April 2021. The status of semi-annual reports due during the review period is set out in Annex I to this Report.

30. Notifications for 1 January - 30 June 2021: As of 26 October 2021, 12<sup>15</sup> Members had notified countervailing actions taken during the period 1 January - 30 June 2021. Seventy-nine Members (including those that submitted one-time notifications) had notified the Committee that they had not taken any countervailing action during this period. Forty-six Members had not submitted a notification. These semi-annual reports were circulated in document series G/SCM/N/379/... and

were reviewed at the Committee's regular meeting held on 26 October 2021. The status of semi-annual reports due during the review period is set out in Annex I to this Report.

31. As of 26 October 2021, the following 45 Members had submitted one-time notifications of having no authority competent to conduct countervailing investigations, of having never taken countervailing actions, and of not anticipating taking any such actions for the foreseeable future: Afghanistan; Angola; Barbados; Belize; Benin; Burkina Faso; Burundi; Cambodia; Cameroon; Congo; Côte d'Ivoire; Cuba; Democratic Republic of the Congo; Dominica; Gabon; The Gambia; Georgia; Guinea; Guyana; Haiti; Hong Kong, China; Kenya; Lao People's Democratic Republic; Liechtenstein; Macao, China; Malawi; Maldives; Mali; Mauritius; Mongolia; Mozambique; Myanmar; Nepal; Papua New Guinea; Saint Kitts and Nevis; Saint Lucia; Senegal; Sierra Leone; Sri Lanka; Suriname; Switzerland; Tonga; Uganda; Vanuatu; and Zambia.<sup>16</sup>

32. A table summarizing notifications of new countervailing duty actions taken by Members during the period 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021, and measures in force as of 30 June 2021, is provided in Annex J to this Report.

## **8 REPORTS ON ALL PRELIMINARY OR FINAL COUNTERVAILING DUTY ACTIONS<sup>17</sup>**

33. Pursuant to Article 25.11 of the Agreement, Members are to report to the Committee without delay all preliminary and final countervailing actions taken. During the review period, the Committee received reports of preliminary and final countervailing actions from Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, European Union<sup>18</sup>, India, Mexico, the United Kingdom, the United States, and Viet Nam (G/SCM/N/369; G/SCM/N/370; G/SCM/N/373; G/SCM/N/374; G/SCM/N/375<sup>19</sup>; G/SCM/N/376; G/SCM/N/377; G/SCM/N/377/Corr.1; G/SCM/N/377/Corr.2; G/SCM/N/378; G/SCM/N/380; G/SCM/N/381; G/SCM/N/382; and G/SCM/N/383). The Committee reviewed these reports of preliminary and final actions at its regular meetings held on 27 April and 26 October 2021.

## **9 TIMELINESS AND COMPLETENESS OF NOTIFICATIONS**

34. As part of the Committee's efforts, pursuant to the 2009 request from the Chairperson of the Trade Policy Review Body, on "ways to improve the timeliness and completeness of notifications and other information flows on trade measures", at the request of the Committee Chairperson the Secretariat circulated document G/SCM/W/546/Rev.12, dated 31 March 2021. The document provides updated information on the state of compliance with various notification obligations under the SCM Agreement. The Committee continued its discussions on this matter at its regular meetings on 27 April and 26 October 2021. At its April and October meetings, the Committee also discussed a revised version of a proposal by the United States on "Guidelines for Submission of Questions and Answers under Articles 25.8 and 25.9" of the SCM Agreement.<sup>20</sup>

## **10 CONSTANT DOLLAR METHODOLOGY FOR GRADUATION FROM SCM AGREEMENT ANNEX VII(B)**

35. Pursuant to the Doha Ministerial Decision on Implementation-Related Issues and Concerns<sup>21</sup> Annex VII (b) to the SCM Agreement lists Members until their GNP per capita reaches US\$1,000 in constant 1990 dollars for three consecutive years, calculated using the methodology set forth in G/SCM/38, Appendix 2. Updated calculations were circulated by the Secretariat in G/SCM/110/Add.18, dated 26 March 2021.

38. At its regular meetings on 27 April and 26 October 2021, the Committee discussed this item upon the request by Australia<sup>23</sup>, Canada<sup>23</sup>, the European Union, Japan<sup>23</sup>, the United Kingdom<sup>23</sup>, and the United States.

**14 PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO PROCEDURES FOR REVIEW OF NEW AND FULL SUBSIDY NOTIFICATIONS – ITEM REQUESTED BY CANADA, THE EUROPEAN UNION, JAPAN, THE UNITED KINGDOM, AND THE UNITED STATES**

39. At its regular meeting on 26 October 2021, the Committee discussed a proposal by Canada, the European Union, Japan, the United Kingdom, and the United States regarding the procedures for review of new and full subsidy notifications.<sup>24</sup>

**15 OTHER BUSINESS**

40. No Member raised any items under "Other Business" at the Committee's regular meetings held on 27 April 2021 and 26 October 2021.
