 - Decreto no 660, of 25 September 1992, instituting Brazil's Foreign Trade Integrated System (SISCOMEX), as amended by Decreto no 8229, of 22 April 2014, adapting SISCOMEX to Brazil's single window initiative. Latest version published in Brazil's Official

Gazette on 23 April 2014.

- Decreto no 2.413, of 4 December 1997, altered by Decreto no 5.473, of 21 June 2005, establishes the jurisdiction of the National Nuclear Energy Commission for extraction, production, import and export of minerals and lithium ores and derivatives. Published in Brazil's Official Gazette on 5 December 1997.
- Portaria Interministerial MF/MICT nº 291, of 12 December 1996, on processing import operations within SISCOMEX. Published in Brazil's Official Gazette on 13 December 1996.
- Portaria SECEX nº 23, of 14 July 2011, consolidating regulations on foreign trade operations. Chapter II regulates import licenses in Brazil, as amended by further Portarias. Published in Brazil's Official Gazette on 19 July 2011.
- Portaria DECEX nº 8, of 13 May 1991, on used goods imports, as amended by further Portarias. Published in Brazil's Official Gazette on 13 May 1991.

6. Other pertinent data or information (i.e. title of the proposed or adopted law/regulation establishing the Import Licensing Procedure):

Most import licensing is statutorily required. For most goods mentioned in the relevant legislative texts, legal coverage is defined within and is not subjected to administrative discretion. Statutorily required licensing cannot be abolished without legislative approval. Other products are left to administrative discretion.
