AGREEMENT ON IMPORT LICENSING PROCEDURES

NOTIFICATION UNDER ARTICLE 5 OF THE AGREEMENT¹

COLOMBIA

The following notification, dated 13 March 2013, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Colombia.

The import of machinery and its parts, classified under tariff subheadings 8429.11.00.00, 8429.19.00.00, 8429.51.00.00, 8429.52.00.00, 8429.59.00.00, 8431.41.00.00, 8431.42.00.00 and 8905.10.00.00, will be subject to a prior licensing regime (non-automatic licence) in order to register and control heavy machinery imported into the country for use in mining and to discourage illegal activity in this sector of the economy.

h. Expected duration of the licensing procedure if this can be estimated with some probability, and if not, reason why this information cannot be provided

Two days, once all the requirements stipulated in Decree 2261 of 2012 have been met. The MinCIT Imports Committee does not consider applications that are submitted without satisfying all of the requirements.

3. Other relevant data or information: (i.e. complete title and data concerning the legislation, inclusion or exclusion of certain products from the import licensing regime and list thereof; changes related to the administrative body(ies) for submission of applications, etc.)

Decree 2261 of 2012 sets out measures to regulate, register and control the import of classifiable subheadings 8429.11.00.00, machinery under 8429.19.00.00, 8429.51.00.00, 8429.52.00.00, 8429.59.00.00, 8431.41.00.00, 8431.42.00.00 and 8905.10.00.00 of the Customs Tariff. It also establishes other provisions to control the use of heavy machinery and chemical imputs that may be used in mining activities without the authorizations or requirements laid down in the law.
