16	Please elaborate the changes in detail (in one of the WTO official languages)	From 16 December 2022, nine substances (i.e., brorphine, clonazolam, CUMYL-PEGACLONE, diclazepam, diphenidine, flubromazolam, isotonitazene, MDMB-4en-PINACA, and metonitazene) have been put under the same strict control as other dangerous drugs under the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance ("DDO"); and three substances (i.e., 4-anilinopiperidine, tert-butyl 4- (phenylamino)piperidine-1-carboxylate, and norfentanyl) added to the control under the Control of Chemicals Ordinance. Also, from 1 February 2023, CBD has been put under the same strict control as other dangerous drugs under the DDO. Hong Kong Harmonized		

Category	Notification details
	System (HKHS) codes of the concerned substances are tabulated in the Annex of this notification. The amendments aimed to deter the trafficking and abuse of these dangerous drugs and substances and help fortify Hong Kong's defence in the fight against drugs.
